

COVID-19 Independent Living Resident Update 6-25-2020

UPDATE: We do have another resident confirmed COVID positive. Fortunately this resident went to the hospital over two weeks ago and has not returned to campus. The incubation period is passed, however they will be self-quarantined upon return.

Arizona continues with staggering increases to the COVID statistics. We will continue on pause without adding or expanding services another week. If the trend continues we may need to pull back on some of the services and access – stay tuned! We will continue to monitor and follow best practices and stay current with guidelines from the CDC, AzDHS and Maricopa County Health Department. Even with all the precautions, risk of contracting the virus remains. The two residents reported last week that are positive for COVID19 continue in self-quarantine. The one staff member that tested positive is self-quarantining at home. Staff members wear masks and follow infection control policies to minimize exposure to others. We are notifying anyone that may have had close contact to encourage testing.

Please contact your primary care physician for information on testing if you are concerned. Testing is also available locally at FastMed urgent care and CVS. Residents may call life enrichment for transportation information to testing sites. Residents are asked to report any positive results so our staff can take precautions and of course they would need to self-quarantine.

We promise to be transparent and forthcoming, as situations develop and change. Updates will be communicated timely via hand delivered notices and on Channel 1960 as well as our website.
